The maximum temperature on the 23rd was $91.8 \& d e g ; F$, a new 13-year daily HIGH maximum temperature record for the date - the old record was $90.3 \&$ deg;F in 2020. The minimum temperature on the 23rd was $71.1 \& \mathrm{deg} ; \mathrm{F}$, a new 13-year warm daily minimum temperature record for the date - the old record was $70.7 \&$ deg; F in 2020 . The maximum temperature on the 24th was $94 \&$ deg;F, a new 13-year daily HIGH maximum temperature record for the date - the old record was $91.3 \& d e g ;$ in 2015 . The maximum temperature on the 25th was $95.4 \&$ deg; $F$, a new 13-year daily HIGH maximum temperature record for the date - the old record was $94 \&$ deg; F in 2011. The minimum temperature on the 25 th was 71.7 \°F, a new 13-year warm daily minimum temperature record for the date - the old record was $70.8 \& d e g ;$ in 2020 .

The maximum temperature on the 27 th was $94.2 \&$ deg; $F$, a new 13-year daily HIGH maximum temperature record for the date - the old record was $93.8 \&$ deg; F in 2020 . The minimum temperature on the 27 th was 75.7 \°F, a new 13-year warm daily minimum temperature record for the date - the old record was $72.5 \&$ deg; $\mathbf{~}$ in 2016 .

The minimum temperature on the 30 th was $72.5 \& \mathrm{deg} ; \mathrm{F}$, a new 13-year warm daily minimum temperature record for the date - the old record was $71.9 \&$ deg; F in 2018 .

## August 2021 Springfield Park

## August was the $2^{\text {nd }}$ wettest August and only last year was wetter. August had 14 days of measurable

 precipitation and tied for $3^{\text {rd }}$ place \& Aug. was the $3^{\text {rd }}$ most humid on record in the past 13 years.The 8.97 inches of rain for August was a +4.01 -inch departure based on a 13 -year average. August had 2.43 inches on the $7^{\text {th }}$ which was also the most rainfall in a day since Aug. $15^{\text {th }} 2020$.

The monthly mean temperature for August was $79.9^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ which was $2.1^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ departure and our $2^{\text {nd }}$ warmest August in the past 13 years. The maximum temperature for August was $96^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ on the $13^{\text {th }}$ and the warmest night was $75.7^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ on the $27^{\text {th }}$. August had 17 days of equal to or greater than $90^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ heat which tied for $3^{\text {rd }}$ place. The lowest August minimum was $59.7^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ on the $5^{\text {th }}$ and there were 23 nights the temperature was equal to or greater than $70^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ which was a new record for August. The average temperature range for August was only $18.6^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$; the 13 -year average is $19.6^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, a negative departure because of the humid air masses we had. The 72.4 average dew point temperature for August as calculated by the Davis Vantage Pro instrument; it was a new high record. August had an average relative humidity of $78.3 \%$.

The max. wind gust was only 33 mph on the $13^{\text {th }}$ from the west at 1730 from a local thunderstorm.

Springfield Park's 16.51 inches of precip. for the summer made 2021 the $5^{\text {th }}$ wettest summer on record.
Springfield Park's 78.8 mean for the summer made 2021 the $5^{\text {th }}$ hottest summer on record.
The summer had 31 days with measurable precipitation which was the $5^{\text {th }}$ least on record.
The summer of 2021 's average relative humidity of $75.5 \%$ was the $5^{\text {th }}$ most humid summer.

## Richmond International Airport

The Richmond International Airport's average mean temperature was $79.9^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ a departure of $+2.4^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ and the $8^{\text {th }}$ hottest August since 1897 and the $9^{\text {th }}$ warmest since 1880 if 1892 is not omitted. The average maximum was $88.9^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$, a $+1.4^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ departure, and the average minimum was $71.0^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ which was a $3.4^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ departure. Only 3 Augusts have had a higher average minimum temperature since 1880. Only August 1900 and 2005 have had higher min. temps or warmer nights. This August had 15 days with temperatures of equal to or greater than $90^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ and 24 nights the low temperature was equal to or greater than $70^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$; the average is 11 for the 123 -year period. The average temperature range for August was only $17.9^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ because of the high humidity; only 29 years have had a lower range for August since 1897. The highest daily temperature range for the month was $24^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ on the $5^{\text {th }}$ and $6^{\text {th }}$ and only 4 Augusts have had a lower range since 1897 . The highest monthly temperature was $95^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ on the $12^{\text {th }}, 13^{\text {th }}, 24^{\text {th }}$. The lowest monthly maximum temperature was $75^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ on the $7^{\text {th }}$. The lowest minimum temperature for August was $61^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$ on the $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$.

The Airport had 7.21 inches of precipitation, a departure of +2.31 inches which made August the $26^{\text {th }}$ wettest since 1887 with 14 days with measurable precipitation.
